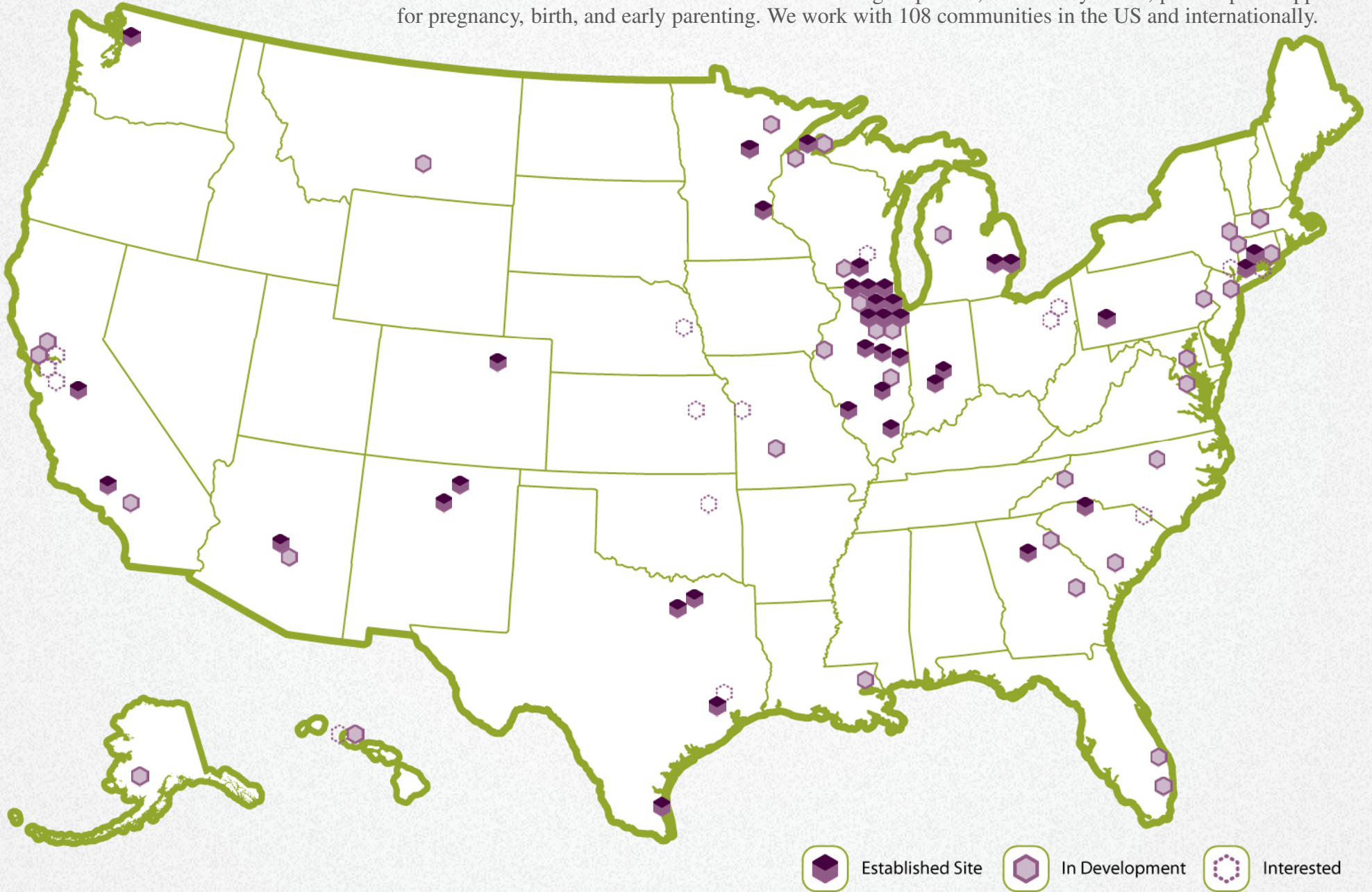


National Community-Based Doula Sites
